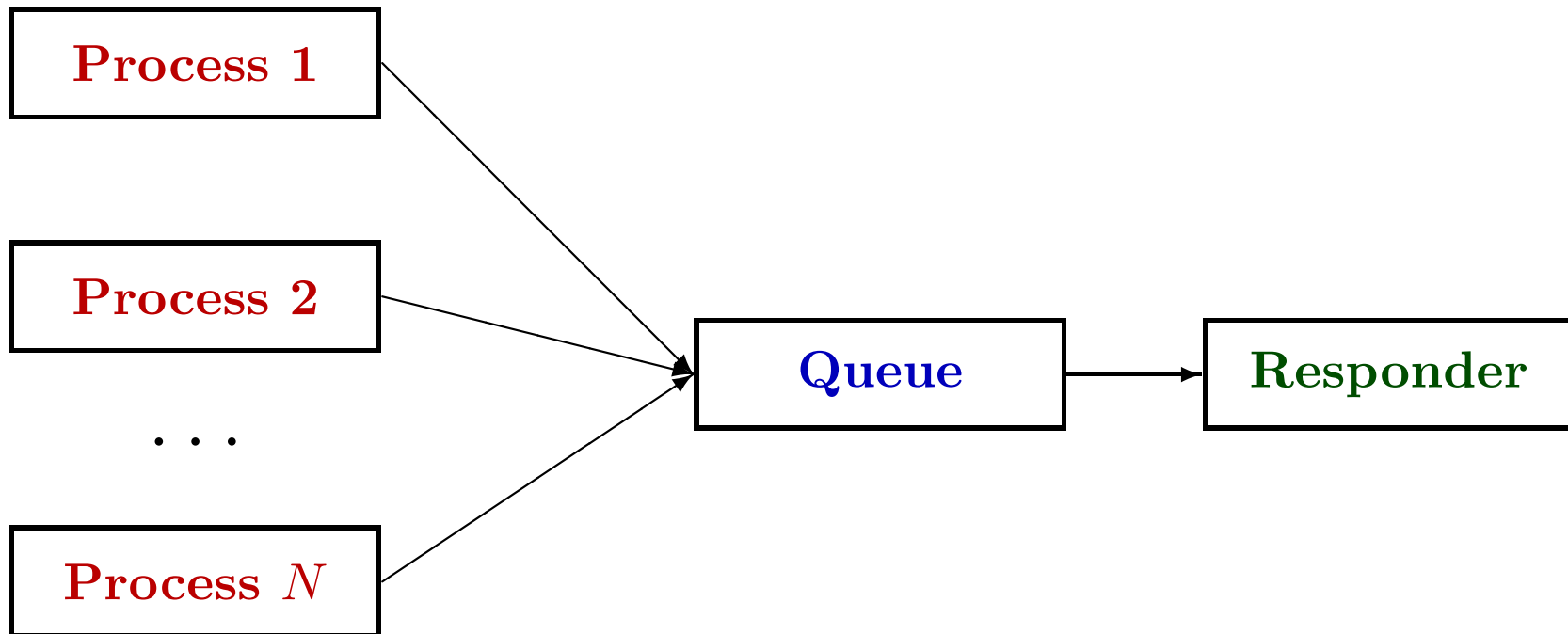


Interprocess communication



- A process may need to communicate an exception or some request for service to a responder without having to stop or suspend execution.
- The responder should be listening for such communication and act when input is available.
- Co-routines allow this.
